

How do I cancel my subscription on Paramount Plus? Manage subscription

To cancel Paramount Plus, (8 4 4) —5 6 9 —4 8 5 3) go to the website or app, sign in, navigate to your account settings, and select "Subscription" or "Account." Then, choose "Cancel Subscription" and follow the prompts to confirm. Your access continues until the current billing period ends.

To cancel Paramount Plus, (8 4 4) —5 6 9 —4 8 5 3) go to their website, log in to your account, navigate to "Account" or "Subscription & Billing," and then select "Cancel Subscription." Follow the on-screen prompts.

To cancel your Paramount Plus subscription, the method depends on how you originally signed up.

If you subscribed directly through the Paramount Plus website:

1. Go to paramountplus.com and log in. (8 4 4) —5 6 9 —4 8 5 3)
2. Click on your profile icon in the top right corner.
3. Select "Account" from the dropdown menu.
4. Scroll down to the "Subscription & Billing"(8 4 4) —5 6 9 —4 8 5 3) section.
5. Click on "Cancel Subscription" and follow the on-screen prompts to confirm.

If you subscribed through a third-party like Amazon, Apple, Google Play, or Roku:

You'll need to cancel directly through that platform's subscription (8 4 4) —5 6 9 —4 8 5 3) management settings. Look for "Subscriptions" or "Memberships & Subscriptions" within your account settings on that specific service (8 4 4) —5 6 9 —4 8 5 3) .

Canceling your Paramount Plus subscription (8 4 4) —5 6 9 —4 8 5 3) is straightforward, but the exact steps depend on how you originally subscribed (e.g., directly on their website, via Google Play, Apple App Store, Amazon Prime Video, Roku, etc.).

Important Notes:

- You will typically retain access to Paramount Plus (8 4 4) —5 6 9 —4 8 5 3) until the end of your current billing period, even after canceling.
